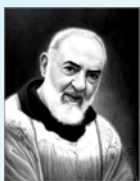

SACRED HEART PADRE PIO PRAYER GROUP



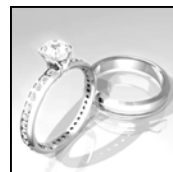
The Padre Pio Prayer Group invites everyone to join us at Sacred Heart Church on **Tuesday, February 7th.**

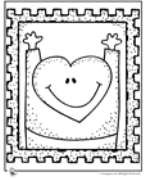
